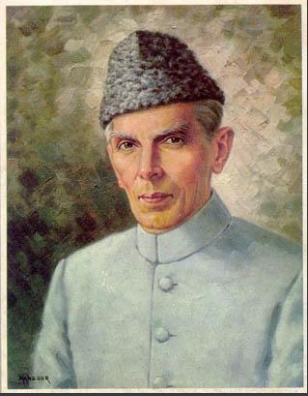

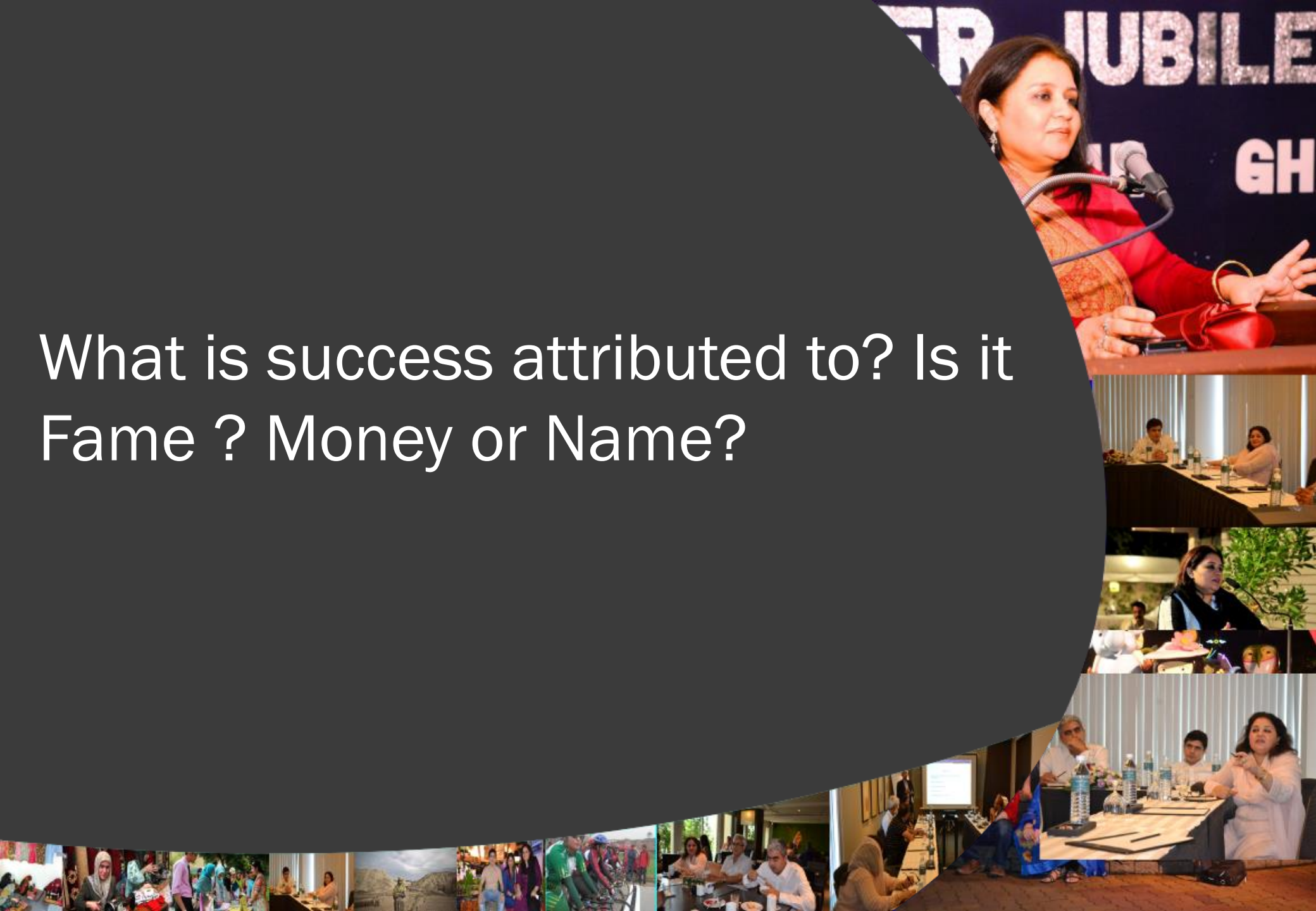




Before sharing a few key moments in my life I would like to define the term success.
